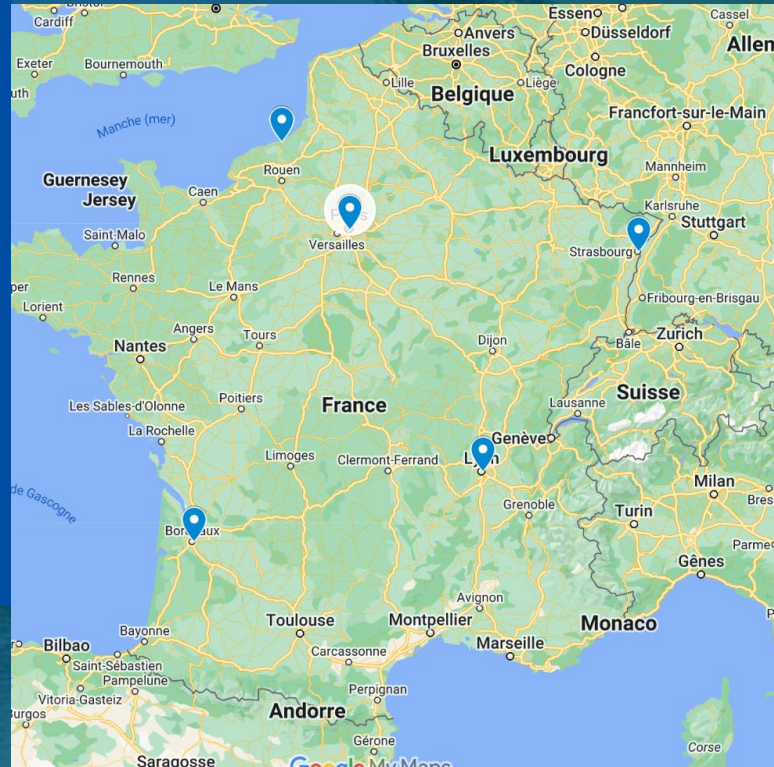

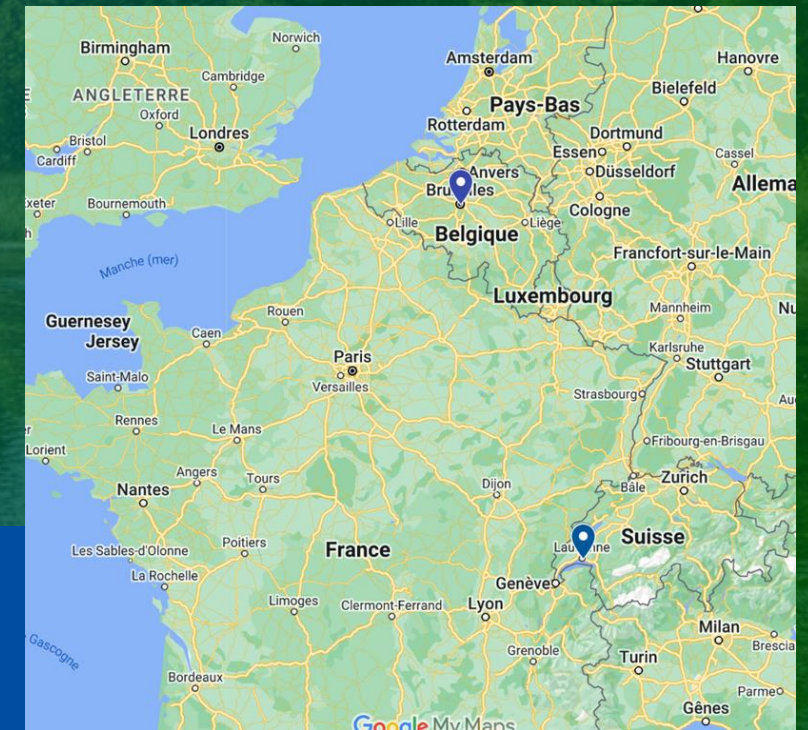


The Churches in France and French-Speaking Churches

- Paris - 100 saints meeting in 4 districts
- Bordeaux - 25 saints
- Lyon - 45 saints
- Dieppe - 15 saints
- Strasbourg - 25 saints



- Lausanne, Switzerland - 20 saints
- Brussels, Belgium - 50 saints



The Ways to “Go”

- ❖ As a student (some as “professional students”) on student visas—to serve the Lord.
- ❖ Taking a job or doing business with working visas—to serve the Lord.
- ❖ As a retiree, or on a non-lucrative visa—to serve the Lord.
- ❖ As a full-timer—to serve the Lord. (*The World Situation and the Direction of the Lord's Move*, ch. 4, by Witness Lee)

Particular burdens for migration (1)

- ❖ Following the model of previous migrations
 - ❖ To England in the early 2000's
 - ❖ To South America beginning in 2010
 - ❖ To Germany beginning in 2016
- ❖ Encouraging all those who migrate to do so in fellowship

Particular burdens for migration (2)

- ❖ A full time team
 - ❖ At least 20
 - ❖ To serve in the follow-up from the gospel labor
 - ❖ To serve all the French speaking churches
 - ❖ Based in Paris

Particular burdens for migration (3)

- ❖ Migrating in different statuses
 - ❖ As a student
 - ❖ Taking a job or doing business with working visas
 - ❖ Doing remote work for your existing company
 - ❖ Being transferred to a local office in France
 - ❖ As a retiree
 - ❖ With a highly skilled visa

Particular burdens for migration (4)

- ❖ Serving full time
 - ❖ All saints serving full time in the work will need the approval of their present locality and of the work
 - ❖ The full time team will be based in Paris, at least for the first several years
- ❖ Migrating in other capacities
 - ❖ We would ask these saints also to fellowship before taking steps to migrate and to migrate in coordination.
- ❖ Keeping the principle of fellowship and coordination

Particular burdens for migration (5)

- ❖ Long stay visitors visa
- ❖ Three requirements
 - ❖ Proof of ability to support yourself for one year
 - ❖ Equivalent of 1767 euros/month
 - ❖ Proof of lodging in France
 - ❖ Proof of private health insurance
- ❖ Can be renewed yearly within France

- ❖ Is migration long term or short term?
- ❖ Do I need to know French to migrate?
- ❖ Where in France is there the need for migration?

Frequently asked questions

- ❖ What will be the function of the full time team?
 - ❖ The team will be based in Paris but its function will be related to the work for the benefit of all the churches in the French speaking countries. Its main functions will be to follow up with the people who have been contacted and to visit the places where there are churches/groups of saints.
- ❖ When should I move if I am going to serve with the full time team?
 - ❖ There is a small team serving full time now. We would like to start with the enlarged team around the beginning of October.

Frequently asked questions

- ❖ How do I know if I have a burden?
 - ❖ Much and thorough prayer (refer to message 3 in this training)
 - ❖ Thorough fellowship with your present locality
 - ❖ Fellowship with the work

Frequently asked questions

- ❖ How is the move to France being overseen?
 - ❖ By the European coworkers in coordination with the coworkers in the US and in Taiwan
 - ❖ LME is functioning as a means to collect the information and facilitate the fellowship.
