

Burdens related to Europe (week of 23 August 2026)

1) September 2026 ITERO in Amsterdam (24-26 September)

The September 2026 International Training for Elders and Responsible Ones (ITERO) will be held in person on 24-26 September in Amsterdam, Netherlands. The general subject will be “The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.” Many leading ones from Europe will attend this training. Please pray that the Lord will release a timely word to all the leading ones and the saints in Europe and around the globe, and that the saints everywhere will receive the revelation and the life supply in this word that will enable them to cooperate with the Lord for the building up of the Body and the preparation of the bride to end this age.

2) First Lord's table in Esch-sur-Alzette, Luxembourg (3-4 October)

The first Lord's table in Esch-sur-Alzette, Luxembourg, is scheduled for the weekend of 3–4 October 2026. An announcement is **available here**, and a link to register is given in the announcement. Please pray for a strong beginning of the Lord's testimony in Luxembourg.

3) Meeting to Establish the Church in Bremen, Germany (18 October)

4) UK building project—a meeting and training facility in London
